
# How to Place a Book on Hold in Destiny Discover



## #1

Go to your school's website and click on the library tab!

Scroll down until you see the Destiny icon and click on it! It looks like a computer screen.



## #2

Welcome to Destiny Discover! Click on the login button in the upper right hand corner.

Sign in through Google Sign-in on the left hand side!

Be sure to use your Google account to sign in. (First two initials+studentID#@chicousd.net Password is your birthdate in yymmdd order).

For example:

Jane Smith would be: js12345@chicousd.net

## #3



1. You can search for a book by title, author, keyword, subject, and/or your AR range using the search bar located at the top of the page! Please only choose from the books that are marked GREEN in the corner!

2. To place a book on hold, simply click on the book you would like to place on hold for check out, and click the blue "hold" button—BUT, make sure it's the book you REALLY want because you cannot "unhold" a book once you click that button!

3. That's it! Your school site's librarian will reach out to you to let you know how the drive-thru pick up and drop-off process will work (if they haven't already done so)!
