### Aeries Communication

Today's Spotlight will be sent out through Aeries Communication. If you do not receive it, please check the following:

- You have created your Parent Portal account
- You have updated your contact information. Your e-mail address and cell phone number must be listed under your name on the contact page. (To edit contacts log into your portal, go to data confirmation, under the student info tab, and then choose contacts)

Please make sure that all contacts listed for your student have a notification preference. The choices for receiving notifications are:

**DO NOT CONTACT** – Meaning that your contact will still be allowed to pick up your student if necessary but won't receive General or Emergency notifications from the school.

**GENERAL AND EMERGENCY** – Meaning that your contact will still be allowed to pick up your student if necessary AND will receive ALL general and emergency announcements. – Such as fundraisers or events or general school-wide information AND school wide emergency announcements.


**EMERGENCY ANNOUNCEMENTS** – Meaning that your contact will still be allowed to pick up your student if necessary AND will receive ALL school wide emergency announcements.
