

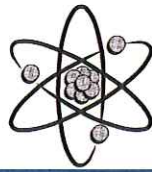

Parkview Elementary School recognizes that birthdays are a special day for our students. We must also ensure that parties and celebrations do not disrupt the instructional day or interfere with the health and safety of all of all students. This year the Parkview team is asking that families refrain from sending in edible birthday treats. As more and more children demonstrate serious food allergies, it becomes harder and harder for us to ensure that all children will be safe eating birthday snacks at school. Additionally, traditional birthday treats like cupcakes, cake, cookies and brownies are filled with sugar and empty calories. We are strongly encouraging families to send non-food items on birthdays. Instead of a food item, please consider sending something for the class to enjoy such as a "Cool School Tool".

Parents should not feel compelled to send in anything to share for their child's birthday. But if you really want to send in something, we ask that you limit your gifts to small, inedible objects like pencils, stickers, tattoos, erasers, silly bands or other very inexpensive items. Instead of a food item, please consider sending something for the class to enjoy such as: A game for the classroom, a classroom book (A nice touch would be having your child pick it out, sign it, and date it.), a classroom set of items for each child to keep such as pencils, pens, erasers, markers, etc.
