Important Update Regarding COVID-19

The Chico Unified School District will be utilizing the new Aeries Parent Portal powered by ParentSquare to help automate student and classroom notifications on campus.

What You Can Expect:

- Notification that your student has been identified as a close contact.
- Notifications will be sent via a secure document, identifying student who was a close contact.
- Notification will provide quarantine options per CDPH guidelines.
- Parents will receive a letter requesting parent to identify their quarantine preference.
- Students who participate in Modified Quarantine will have the ability to perform daily wellness checks from ParentSquare app.

The notification process will continue to evolve as we receive input from our families.
