6.1 ADMINISTRATION-Heather

- Parent conferences are coming up on 11/9
- Thursday the 26th is Harvest Festival (put on by PTO)
 - Fundraising for 5th grade - hot dogs and hot chocolate will be sold.
- Visit last week from Chico State theatre group - Opera Flute

6.2 ENGLISH LEARNER (ELAC)-Pauline

- ELAC meeting (heather and Pauline) on October 3rd
- This meeting is for all non-english speaking parents
- 3 parents volunteered to go to DLAC meeting at district.
- Parkview is still a Title 1 school - Funding. However, it's likely to change next year with the recent changes in demographics.
- Discuss student testing to assess their English language skills.
 - Students are labeled as ELL based on forms filled out by parents during registration.
 - Once "tagged", you have 30 days to give students their initial CELT.
 - Program on campus called Language Star works with these students.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Item 7 Introduce and review LCAP/SPSA

- Single Plan..... is how our school will operate (goals for Parkview).
- District has merged these plans, so that our SPSA is aligned with our LCAP.
- LCAP
 - Currently revising our 2017/18 budget
 - Missing piece right now - books from last year do not accurately reflect budget for this year.
 - Once we have more data from the district, we can review how efficient our spending was and proceed with goal setting.
- State Assessments
 - Parents have access to state SBAC dashboard (www.caschooldashboard.org)
 - We can also look at this site, look at Parkview, and identify info related to the state indicators (graduation rate, academic performance, suspension rate, english learners progress, preparation for college/career, chronic absenteeism).
 - Through this Equity Report (at an elementary level) they are looking to tie the success of a 2nd grader (in reading) with the success of that student in 5th grade, and success in 5th grade relating to their high school graduation rate.
- PBIS - a shift to make suspension your last stop. This is our behavior plan for Parkview (as well as the district).
 - No longer have a "reset" site, McManus, for students who are suspended.
 - Leslie brings up expulsion - students go to a hearing and are exited from the district.
- Heather pulls up 2016/17 Smarter Balances results for Parkview

- ELA 52% kids on level or above
- ELA 48% standard nearly or not met
 - 15.1% Nearly
 - 33% Not met
- We can compare Parkview to other schools.
- Our goal for this year is to see a 5% increase for: standards exceeded and standards met.
- Leslie - How do we decided how it will go? How do we ensure it happens?
- Heather - PLC's to help create smart goals and identify students who need extra support.
- Greg - can we look at each grade level and see if they are progressing? Shouldn't they be the strongest coming out of 5th grade?
- We can now look at teacher by teacher, how their students are testing and create a focus specific to the teacher.
- Math
 - 49% for exceeding or met.
 - %51 for not met.
- Smarter Balanced Performance Summary - Multi-Year Comparison
 - Our goal was to increase by %5, but we didn't meet our goal last year.
 - Our goal again is to increase by %5.

LCAP/SPSA Goals

- District goals are set at the top.
- Site then decides how they should work to meet this goal.
- Matrix covers specific action steps, timelines, materials needed, funding, etc.
- Money will come from the district to our site.
- Heather will meet with the district at the end of this month to receive a final look at our budget and goals.
- Heather goes over our last year goals. What our goals were, what we're covering right now, and what we'll look to change.
- This is just a preview of what we'll have to discuss at later meeting in November.
